

Operating your Single Color Ultimate Remote

- The LOCK button (upper left) is used to turn on your lights. If you press it a 2nd time the lights will FLASH. Pressing it a 3rd time will cause the lights to flash more slowly. Pressing it a 4th time returns the lights to their original setting (non-flashing).

- Pressing the UNLOCK button causes the lights to BREATHE. This means they slowly dim and brighten again. Pressing the button a 2nd time slows the function. A third click further slows the breathing and a fourth time returns it to full speed.

- Pressing the LIGHTENING BOLT button will cause your lights to STROBE. This is a flashing pattern similar to what emergency vehicles use.



DO NOT ride with your lights in STROBE MODE or you will very likely get pulled over. Pressing the button a 2nd or 3rd time switches to a slightly different strobe pattern. Return to the original pattern by pressing the button a fourth time.

- Pressing the BELL button TURNS OFF your lights.

NOTE: If you have a hard-wired push-button switch on your light and you turn your lights off using the pushbutton switch, you have to turn them back on in the same manner. The remote will not control the lights when they've been turned off using the pushbutton switch. Once you push the switch the controller is now powered, use key fob to turn lights on!

There's a built-in setting within the remote that will automatically shut off your lights after one hour, as to not drain your battery.
